This policy details how data about you is collected/used/disclosed when you visit our websites and services (together, "Scholar Swap") or otherwise interact with us. If we update it, we will revise the date, place notices on Scholar Swap if a change is material, and/or obtain your consent as required by law.

1. Protecting your privacy

- We take precautions to prevent unauthorized access to or misuse of data about you.
- We run ads on the site from Google AdSense.
- We do not share your data with third parties for marketing purposes.
 - However, it should be noted that the offers themselves can be viewed publicly, without the offer owner's name. It is up to the user to ensure there is no personal data in the actual offer, and they use the secure messaging system to organize their swaps.
- We do not engage in cross-marketing or link-referral programs with other sites.
- We do not employ tracking devices for marketing purposes HOWEVER
 - Google through their ads may do so as per their agreements. Please read through their privacy policies.
- We do not send you unsolicited communications for marketing purposes.
- We do not engage in affiliate marketing (and prohibit it on Scholar Swap).
 - We do however provide a non-intrusive local advertising service. Please see the advertising information page for information on this (<http://scholar-swap.com/advertising.html>)
- Scholar Swap links to third party sites - please review their privacy policies.
- It is against site rules to post personal information on offers- this is to protect the user's privacy.
 - Any extra information posted by the user is not the responsibility of Scholar Swap. It is up to the user to be safe while using this site.
- We implement many safety strategies in order to keep your data safe, such as sanitizing all inputs, keeping passwords only in a hashed form, and making HTTPS connection to our server(s) default and mandatory.

2. Data we use to provide/improve our services and/or combat fraud/abuse:

- data you post on Scholar Swap, or send us directly or via other sites. Please do not post private data.
- data you provide (e.g. email address, name).
- web log data (e.g. pages viewed, access times, IP address, HTTP headers).
- data collected via cookies (e.g. keyword searches and "favorites" lists).
- data about your devices (e.g. screen size, DOM local storage, plugins).
- data from 3rd parties (e.g. phone type, general location derived from IP address).

3. Data we store

- We retain data as long as needed for our business purposes and/or as required by law.
- We make good faith efforts to store data securely, but make no guarantees.

- You may access and update certain data about you by logging into your account.

4. Circumstances in which we may disclose user data:

- to respond to subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process.
- to protect our rights, property, or safety, or that of our users or the general public.
- with your consent (e.g. if you authorize us to share data with other users).
- in connection with a merger, bankruptcy, or sale/transfer of assets to another company.
- in aggregate or summary form, as long as it cannot reasonably be used to identify you.

International Users - By visiting Scholar Swap or providing us data, you agree we may use and disclose data we collect for purposes listed here or as communicated to you, transmit it outside your resident jurisdiction, and store it on servers in the United States.
